- Results are not discussed with the client unless an emergency condition is diagnosed and the referring veterinarian cannot be immediately contacted.
- The client will be invoiced at the end of the procedure and full payment will be required at this time.
- All patients for endoscopic procedures will be admitted to the hospital
- Clients should be encouraged to have their pet fasting after 8pm the night before an upper GIT endoscopy and rhinoscopy.
- Please contact the clinic for instructions regarding colonoscopy procedures.
- Please inform us if there are any known handling concerns
- To ensure the safety of the procedures performed and the appropriate use of endoscopy we suggest key aspects of the case be worked up prior to referral (including, but not limited to routine haematology, biochemistry, electrolytes, abdominal and chest x-rays).
- To establish that endoscopy is the most appropriate diagnostic step, and to help in localising GI disease, we strongly recommend that patients have abdominal ultrasonography performed prior to endoscopy (as deemed appropriate for the case).
- Please inform the client that Moss Veterinary Hospital is not a specialist endoscopy centre and procedures are performed at a general practitioner level.
